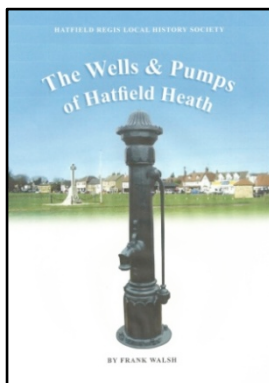

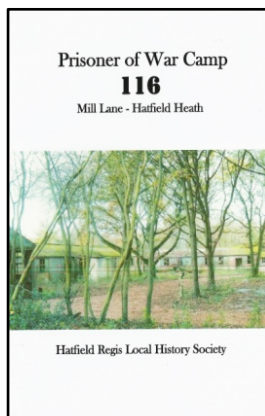


The Pumps and Wells of Hatfield Heath

Prisoner of War Camp 116, Mill Lane, Hatfield Heath



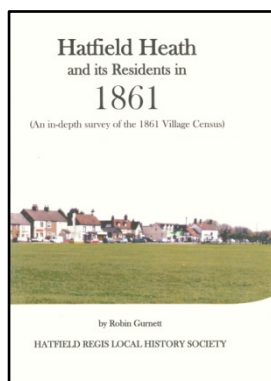
